Our campaign has been in existence since early 2001. We were formed to oppose the threats to civil liberties embodied in the UK's Terrorism Act 2000. Our work was soon extended considerably, as a result of later events. We have organised major demonstrations in London against government legislation, and have supported a legal challenge to the banning of political organisations under the Terrorism Act 2000. We are closely monitoring the rapidly evolving events in terms of proposals for new legislation and individual cases concerning infringement of civil rights and abuses of state power.

CAMPACC remains the only broad campaign bringing together lawyers, activists, refugee communities and anti-globalisation campaigners that consistently fights against the alarming erosion of civil liberties in this country. The campaign is now planning to put itself on a more formal basis with regular mailings, briefing papers and occasional publications, developing the web site and employing a part-time co-ordinator.

But these ambitious plans all demand money and resources. We are seeking to establish a subscription based-supporters' list with people paying £10 per year (£5 unwaged) to give us a sound financial basis for our vital activities.
